ADDENDUM TO THE VOLUNTEER APPLICATION

Code of Conduct:

1. The consumption of alcohol, non-pharmaceutical drugs or tobacco is prohibited.
2. Modest dress is expected by all. There are to be no extremes in clothing (see-through clothing, skimpy clothing or clothing that depicts violence or drugs/alcohol products). Males must wear t-shirts at all times (except for swimming during personal time) and females are not to expose their midriff.
3. "Lights Out" is strictly enforced at 11:00 p.m.
4. Two staff members of the opposite sex must not be found together alone.
5. Boys' accommodations are "off limits" to girls and vice versa.
6. All valuables and medications are the responsibility of each team member.
7. All staff must follow community-specific rules regarding after-hours activities. All activities must be approved by team leaders and must be in groups.
8. All facilities will be treated with respect and left in a cleaner state than we found them.
9. No crude or profane language is tolerated.
10. Any serious violation of the Code of Conduct may result in the team member being sent home at their own expense.

Lifestyle Expectations:

Pathway staff members **are expected to:**

1. be willing to follow all instructions,
2. consistently participate in the community of a Bible-believing church,
3. be willing to set aside personal freedoms on debatable issues (e.g. drinking) for the sake of unity
4. model respect and godly behaviour to campers at all times, and
5. be willing to accept the non-denominational aspect of the team, avoiding divisive theological issues, and
6. have a desire to be Christ-like in attitude and conduct.

Pathway staff members will reflect a lifestyle in harmony with Scriptural teaching and **will not be involved** with behavior that includes (but is not limited to) the following:

1. Criminal activity
2. Substance abuse
3. The use of pornographic material
4. Theft or vandalism
5. Sexual assault or harassment
6. Lying or deceitfulness
7. Sexual relationships outside of marriage
8. Crude or profane behavior or language.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. We believe that all the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, is inspired by God, and is therefore the ultimate authority for belief and behaviour.
2. We believe in one God who exists as God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.
3. We believe that Jesus Christ is God manifest in the flesh; we affirm his virgin birth, sinless humanity, divine miracles, bodily resurrection, ascension, ongoing mediatorial work, and personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe all men and women being created equally in the image of God have intrinsic dignity and worth. People are unable to be in right relationship with God due to original and continual rebellion against him. They need to be made alive spiritually and restored to a relationship with God.
5. We believe that though we deserve eternal punishment and separation from God for our disobedience, God loves us and sent Christ to die in our place to restore our relationship with God.
6. We believe that God makes us right with himself when we put our faith in Christ and what he has done for us through his life, death and resurrection.
7. We believe in the final resurrection of the dead, both of believers in Christ and of unbelievers.
8. We believe that believers in Christ will experience eternal life with God and unbelievers will experience eternal separation from him.
