- 7. How did the husband treat Hannah on the occasion of feasts? Why? (1:5, 8)
- 8. How was Hannah treated? $(\underline{1:6})$
- 9. Who observed Hannah in the temple? $(\underline{1:9}, \underline{13})$
- 10. *What was Hannah's emotional state when the feasting ended? $(\underline{1:10})$
- 11. What was Hannah's vow before the Lord? $(\underline{1:11})$
- 12. What did Eli assume about Hannah? (<u>1:13-14</u>)
- 13. How did Hannah explain her behavior? (1:15-16)
- 14. What was Eli's response to Hannah's situation? $(\underline{1:17})$
- 15. *How did Hannah's mood change after she had prayed? (1:18)
- 16. How was Hannah's prayer answered? $(\underline{1:19-20})$
