- i. God was there first not you.
- ii. God has others doing His work not just you.
- iii. God does His work over time not all at once.
- iv. God asks us to be faithful not fruitful.
- v. God asks us to witness out of love & joy not fear or guilt.
- III. Three Things to do while Waiting for the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:12 26)
- i. Be Joined Together in Fellowship (vs. 12 17)
- ii. Be Constant in Prayer (vs. 14)
- iii. Be Led by the Holy Spirit (vs. 15 26)

Questions for Reflection / Discussion:

- i. According to Lifeway Research most Christians in Canada do not share their faith or witness. What do you believe are the primary reasons for this? Discuss.
- ii. Which of the five points on being a fruitful witness was most relevant for you? What other points would you want to add to this list? Discuss.
- iii. The people that formed the first church were from a cross-section of society whose lives had been touched by Jesus and reclaimed by His grace. What can we learn about how to do church from them? How are the challenges we face different from theirs, or the same?
