

<u>Paul in Ephesus:</u> <u>Man-Made gods are no gods at all!</u> (Acts 18:18 – 19:41)

Study Notes Handout: Oct 1st

You see and hear how this fellow Paul has convinced and led astray large numbers of people here in Ephesus and in practically the whole province of Asia. He says that man-made gods are no gods at all. There is danger not only that our trade will lose its good name, but also that the temple of the great goddess Artemis will be discredited, and the goddess herself, who is worshipped throughout the province of Asia and the world, will be robbed of her divine majesty. When they heard this, they were furious and began shouting. 'Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!' (Acts 19:26 - 28)
