#### John's Purpose in Writing:

John writes Christians so we might know what true fellowship with God (and joy in God) looks like, that we might know the part we play in maintaining it, and that we might know the forces at work against us to destroy it.

Sermon Outline: The Source of our Fellowship with God is Jesus Christ.

- 2. The Jesus that was from the beginning (1:1)
- 3. The Jesus that appeared to the Apostles (1:2)
- 4. The Jesus that was proclaimed by the Apostles (1:3-4)

- i. How is fellowship with God a key theme all throughout Scripture, beginning in Genesis?
- ii. How is the person of Jesus Christ central to our fellowship with God? What alternative ideas have you heard someone propose about the heart of Christianity?
- iii. Why are both the deity and the humanity of Jesus essential tenets of the Christian faith?
- iv. How is fellowship similar to and different from friendship? What interrupts your assurance of fellowship with God most?
