God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him. In this way, love is made complete among us...There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love. - 1 John 4:16ff

Introduction: Synopsis of the Sermon

The perfecting of God's love in us takes time. It takes place in the relationships He leads us into. As we increasingly live in Him and let Christ rule in us, the proof is seen in how we love. John teaches that our families, friendships (and all other relationships) are 'laboratories of love' designed to test and perfect the love of God in us so that we might be ready to meet Him on the Day of Judgement without fear. Love is serious business. It reveals the true condition of our hearts, which determines our eternal destiny... *because in this world we are like Him* (4:17).

 'Mystery Meal' this evening, consider discussing the following question together:

- For you to Talk with God about Privately If you are a Christian then God lives in you (4:12) and He has given you His Spirit (4:13) who enables you to live in the love of God and show His love to others (4:16).
