Open It

1. Why do we tend to draw closer to God during times of trial than times when everything is going well?

Explore It

- 2. What did Potiphar observe about Joseph, and what did he do as a result? (39:2-6)
- 3. What did Potiphar's wife ask Joseph to do, and what was his response? (39:7-12)
- 4. How did Potiphar's wife react when Joseph refused her? (39:13-18)
- 5. How did Potiphar respond to his wife's story? (39:19-20)
- 6. What happened to Joseph in prison? (39:21-23)

Get It

- 7. Put yourself in Joseph's place. How would you have reacted if you had found yourself in a slave caravan heading toward Egypt? How would you have responded to your new masters?
- 8. What evidence is there that God was in control of Joseph's circumstances? How much of God's control would Joseph have seen at the time?
- 9. Why did Joseph rise so quickly to a position of authority? What part did God play in those events? What part did Joseph play?
- 10. Why is sexual purity so important?
- 11. How can we resist sexual temptation?
