The Lord’s Supper and the Early Church

1 Corinthians 11:17-34

Events that led up to Jesus and His disciples sharing the Passover meal together:

The Passover meal:

- Jesus changes the Passover liturgy

Responsive Reading:

All: Our Lord is praiseworthy; Our Lord is king of the universe; He has created the fruit of the vine.

Father: The Lord bless you and keep you: The Lord make His face to shine upon you and have mercy on you! May the Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace!
