- 1. **Mary lived in a weary world - politically, spiritually, and personally.**

 - What does her story teach us about the kind of people God uses, and how does that challenge our assumptions about worth or significance?
- 3. **Mary's calling came with real-world consequences - loss of reputation, uncertainty, relational strain.**
 - Why do you think God's call is often costly, and how have you experienced obedience leading to both blessing and difficulty?
- 4. **Mary said, "I am the Lord's servant... may Your word to me be fulfilled."**
 - What does surrender to God look like in your current season of life, and what makes surrender difficult for you?
