

Mercy Quiz Instructions

(page 1 of 2)

Read the scenario and each response option. Challenge kids to choose which response shows mercy. Instruct kids to color in each numbered box on the picture sheet according to the color corresponding to the correct answer for that numbered scenario.

1. A kid who made fun of you last week just dropped his lunch tray on the floor in the cafeteria.	Look the other way and pretend you didn't notice. PURPLE	Help him clean up and get some more food. YELLOW	Point and laugh at him. GREEN
2. Your younger sister fell down and got hurt.	Ask if she is OK and get help for her. BLUE	Blame her for not being more careful. BROWN	Tell her she is fine. YELLOW
3. Your friend is sad because her pet is sick and might not live much longer.	Say, "I'm sorry about your pet." RED	Say, "Maybe you can get a new pet." PINK	Say, "It's just an animal." ORANGE
4. A classmate laughed at the outfit you were wearing, and you felt embarrassed.	Tell your classmate you don't like his clothes either. BLACK	Tell your classmate you like his choice of clothing. BLUE	Start a mean rumor about your classmate. RED

5. Your neighbor is having a birthday party, but you were not invited.	Pray that God will send rain to ruin the party. PINK	Vow to never speak to your neighbor again. BLUE	Invite your neighbor to your next party. YELLOW
6. Your brother is upset because he lost one of his new toys.	Let him borrow one of your toys. GREEN	Scold him for not taking better care of his stuff. BLUE	Tell him his toy wasn't that great anyway. ORANGE
7. Your friend is feeling nervous about an upcoming test she forgot to study for.	Point out that you feel confident because you studied a lot. RED	Pray for her and offer to help her review. YELLOW	Tell her she made a big mistake by not studying. PURPLE
8. A teammate feels embarrassed because he attempted the game-winning shot and missed.	Tell him he should have passed the ball to a stronger player. ORANGE	Suggest he spend more time practicing. PINK	Give him a high-five and tell him he did his best. RED
9. One of your classmates has been home sick for an entire week.	Waiting until she comes back to school to ask her how she is feeling. BLUE	Offer to bring her homework and share any class updates. GREEN	Stay far away so you don't catch any of her germs. YELLOW
